

We count on alarms to warn us of fires, smoke and dangerous gases, inclement weather, home invasions, business break-ins and to wake us up in the morning or remind us to take our medicine. A lot of money is invested in these alarms. We depend on them to be reliable and we are wise to heed their warnings. It would be foolish if we ignored every alarm and shrugged it off as irrelevant. Deactivating them without investigation because it's annoying could bring serious bodily and property consequences.

Our conscience is like an alarm. When we feel guilty it's wise to heed that alarm and turn from that danger that affects our relationship with God. We are sinners who like to sin, it's who we are as human beings. We need God to change us into his likeness and we need to obey him and listen to his warnings. The more we ignore his alarms the easier it is to continue in that pattern. The more we think we are hiding our sin, the easier it is to believe that we are hiding it from God. The Holy Spirit is God's gift to us that lives in us to warn, encourage and strengthen us every day in every situation.
