
"Because Answers Only Exist To Questions..."

Get ready! Another exciting sermon series begins in January! Have you ever asked yourself why did Jesus ask so many questions in the Gospels? There are over 100 examples in the Bible of Jesus asking questions from all who gathered around him as he taught.

The favorite response of children to our explanations is, "Why?" Jesus knew once he got people talking, he could then sharpen the discussion with a zinger of a question like he did to Peter one day: "Who do you say that I am?" In the midst of so many words and thoughts, Peter finally answered: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." While working on the 17 foot statue of David, Michelangelo stated, "I saw an angel in the marble and I carved until I set him free."

I wondered if this is similar to what God sees and does with us. Somehow, he sees the good in us and chisels away until he sees more of his likeness and frees us from our bondage to sin. We are truly free when we accept his sacrifice at the cross. We're free from the bondage of sin, the hopelessness, uncertainty and worry of death. This carving into his perfect likeness is a lifelong process. We become more and more like Christ as he molds us. We're not stone and yet our hearts can be like stone.
