

What an amazing week we had at the South Campus and then the North Campus! The crew of the "Starship Courage" took **527 space cadets** at South Campus and **249 space cadets** at North Campus on a different mission each day! They experienced the amazing power of God on their four different missions. They realized that the Lord your God is with you wherever you go!
