

## THE TRANSFIGURATION OF JESUS

#### READ: Matthew 17:1-9

Holy events often happen on the tops of mountains in the Bible. This is one of those stories. Jesus takes three disciples with him, Peter, James and John. When they arrive, Jesus is transformed. His face and clothes become very bright. With Jesus, there is Moses and Elijah. Peter is amazed and responds by asking if he should build shelters for Moses, Elijah and Jesus. In that moment, a voice is heard from within a cloud. The voice says, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased. Listen to him!" The disciples fall to their faces in fear, but Jesus lifts them up saying, "Do not be afraid." Moses and Elijah are gone. The voice in the cloud is silent, and Jesus has returned to his former appearance.

The event served its purpose for Jesus himself and the disciples. As Jesus is preparing to soon do the most difficult part of his ministry (the passion and crucifixion) this event is a powerful affirmation from the Father. For the disciples, this event also strengthens them in their faith to follow and listen to Jesus when it will become the most difficult to do so. For us, it helps us see Jesus as divine, close to the Father, and readies us to follow him through thick and thin.
