On a Mission from God MECHANICS GIVE AWAY 100TH CAR



"Bonnie Giles grinned ear to ear as she started the old off-white minivan for the first time and honked the horns to the cheers of a small crowd Saturday afternoon, June 30, at a repair shop in Moorhead. On the windows, written in red, it said '100th car giveaway," the article in the Forum stated.

"God blessed me when I didn't deserve it, through YWCA and a couple of guys named Matt and Jeremy," said Giles, a survivor of abuse.

Matt Carlson and Jeremy Jensen started Higher Power Automotive Ministries three years ago to offer free repairs to those in need. A year and a half ago, they started giving away cars that had been donated to them.

The nonprofit group has been so successful that, to ensure it could continue to grow, Carlson started a business three months ago at 2620 2nd Ave. N. Moorhead, called Fix It Forward. Professional mechanics work on cars for paying customers in the daytime and volunteers work on cars for free at night or weekends. The business provides space, expensive equipment, and, crucially, liability insurance for the nonprofit.

The group now has about 50 volunteers who work on cars and about half as many taking care of other needs, such as marketing and scheduling, he said. "This is totally God's hand," Jensen told the crowd. "It's just been amazing what God has done!"

Tami Rust, a YWCA executive who works with donors, said having a reliable vehicle is crucial for the women her group works with to get back on their feet, allowing them to get to work or job interviews, go to doctors' appointments and visit family.

Until Higher Power came along, the YWCA just didn't have an easy way taking care of its clients' transportation needs, she said.

The YWCA is now one of the dozens of groups Higher Power relies on to vet clients.
