POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Educating & Nurturing

 - Help students learn attitudes, skills, and subject matter that will contribute to their development as mature, able, and
 responsible Christians to the praise and glory of God
 - Assist the Children's Ministry Administrator in weekly maintenance of equipment and materials
 - Assist with registration of children and classroom assignments
 - Responsible for collection of monetary offerings within the classroom
- 2. Overseeing Volunteers
 - Recruit, coordinate, train and thank volunteers for each specific grade level
 - Lead and assist volunteers during Wednesday evening or Sunday morning sessions
 - Be a Christian role model in attitude, speech and actions towards others
- 3. Special Events
 - Oversee curriculum preparation and organization of special events including, but not limited to; 3rd-grade Bible Event, 5th-grade First Communion and Vacation Bible School
 - Nurture children's spiritual growth and transformation in cooperation with their parents/ guardians and the rest of the church community.
