

ASH WEDNESDAY

Ash Wednesday worship is an opportunity to reflect on our mortality, sinfulness and need of a savior: to renew our commitment to daily repentance in all areas of our life; and to remember with confidence and gratitude that Christ has conquered death and sin.

IMPOSITION OF ASHES

As you come forward for Communion you will have the opportunity to have a cross marked on your forehead with ashes. The ashes are meant to signify two things: our repentance and recognition that we have turned from God in thought, attitude and behavior, and the ashes mark our mortality and our recognition of the limitations of our strength and will. We are dependent and created beings. As the cross of ashes is placed on our forehead, we hear again these ancient words from Genesis: Remember that you are dust and to dust you shall return. If you do not wish to be marked with the ashes, simply pass by without stopping and receive Communion.
