- 5) I understand that my time in the nursery should be spent singing, talking and playing with the children in my care and I'm to share the love of Jesus with the babies and toddlers. \_\_\_\_\_
- 6) I will teach the children to focus on God, but, also, show how special each child is and how much they are loved! \_\_\_\_\_
- 7) I understand that it's never too early to teach of God's love and care and that it's my job, not to babysit, but to teach these little ones of God's grace even as we show grace to them. \_\_\_\_\_
- 8) I will remember to keep my full attention on the children and never leave them unattended. \_\_\_\_\_
- 9) I will greet parents with a warm smile and give a brief, positive report about the child's time in the classroom. If problems need to be discussed, I will refer them to the Lead Teacher. \_\_\_\_\_
