Pride is the deadliest of all the deadly sins. All human beings struggle with pride. We all secretly love a gospel that relies on me, myself and I. The reason is that if am self-reliant I don't have to answer to anybody including God. I can do anything I want and I am not accountable to anyone. This leads to arrogance and a distancing from God to the point of disobedience and eventually, unbelief. Humility is the antidote to pride. A humble heart bends a knee to God, confessing both a need for God's forgiveness and a desire to have our lives transformed by His amazing grace. A humble heart looks at the cross of Christ and sees a vision of the humility of God that draws us towards an image of humility that changed the world and is changing the lives of all who follow Him. Our challenge is to take the words of scripture at face value, "Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the faith God has distributed to each of you."
