We Receive, We Give, We Invite

Jesus is about bringing hope to people and giving healing to the wounded. And since this is what Jesus does, then this is what we, His church do. During Lent we will follow Jesus in three ways when it comes to **hope and healing**. First, we receive it. Then we give it. And finally, we invite others into it.

We Receive

We want you to receive hope and healing through **two different ways**.

1. **Worship** is one way to receive hope and healing. Throughout Lent, Wednesday and Sunday worship services will have different sermon series. It's an opportunity for many of you to worship both Wednesdays and Sundays and to go deeper into your relationship with Jesus.

2. **Hope and Healing Course** has been developed and will be taught by Hope's pastors. It is offered twice on Sundays, **March 8-29:**

6:30pm at South Campus

This is a course for every adult as we are all broken by sin. Those who have specific hurts in their lives will find it especially beneficial.

Not only do we receive hope and healing, but we also give it.


We will be giving an offering to the **New Life Center and Churches United for the Homeless**.
