### Job summary

Primary functions will include: set up, tear down and operation of audio, visual, and lighting equipment for church events i.e. Sunday and Wednesday worship; funerals; weddings; and confirmation events. Event technicians will be expected to work closely with the pastors, music leaders and music team by helping to meet their needs in both audio and visual elements of the worship environment in a prompt and professional manner.

### Summary of essential job functions

Event technicians will be expected to:

- Learn on the job and adapt to the ever-changing landscape of event technology.
- Push, lift, carry, wrap, crawl, and otherwise do light manual labor.
- Sit for extended periods of time while remaining attentive.
- Learn to turn subjective concepts about sound, video, and lights into objective and rewarding results.
- Solve puzzles. Mostly the ones that start with “why doesn’t this work”.
- Be the first to arrive and the last to leave.
- We aspire to be Joyful, cool under pressure, professional, attentive, responsive, and punctual.

### Minimum requirements

Have a mind for learning how sound and video equipment work, a heart for worshipping the Lord, and a professional and positive attitude.

### Abilities required

Being professional, being able to lift up to 45lbs, prioritizing tasks and utilizing problem solving skills.
