Conclusion

The Apostle Paul knew God personally and it changed his entire life. He went from seeking after Christians to put an end to this movement of Christianity, to seeking after Christ. His primary goal was not to become more spiritual, or knowledgeable about religion, but was to *know* Christ. For Paul, it was very personal. He changed from seeking after status and success to recognizing that all the success in this world does not mean anything if we cannot take it with us when we die. Therefore, he counted everything in this world as a loss compared to knowing Jesus Christ his Lord. In that same way, we acknowledge that God has made it possible for us to know Him and have a relationship with Him by sending His one and only Son into the world. Through the death and resurrection of Jesus, by faith we can be made right with God. Our sins can be forgiven, and we can be made new creations. The offer is on the table. The question is- will we continue to live the way that this world wants us to live, or will we choose to receive His forgiveness, and move forward living how Jesus wants us to live?
