WHO CAN GO?

YOUNG ADULT: 15 participants (2022 high school graduates through age 25)

2 staff (Katie Van Dame & Paul Norell)

HOW MUCH WILL IT COST?

The cost of the trip will be capped at \$2,000. Transportation costs greatly impact the final total, with flights still being determined.

SCHOLARSHIP & FUNDRAISING OPPORTUNITIES

*Letter Writing & Social Media Stories: share your "why" for serving the people of Jamaica with family and friends. Ask them to support you through prayer, letters, and financial contributions. Resources available upon request.

WHAT DOES THE TRIP LOOK LIKE?

TRANSPORTATION: We will leave by bus and fly out of MSP. Return flights to MSP will likely be late evening followed by a bus ride returning to Fargo.

WORK: We will assist with local building/painting projects, restore ministry facilities and grounds, and build relationships with kids in area schools/churches.

FAITH: Daily worship/devotional time with small groups.

PLAY: Waterfall hiking, swimming, exploring local culture and more!

LODGING: in Montego Bay – dorm style bunk beds. Males and females will have separate lodging rooms for both trips (no exceptions, including for married couples for YA trip).

HEALTH/SAFETY CONCERNS: Hydration, sun/heat, food restrictions & allergies (let us know)! Healthcare emergencies with hospital nearby. We also try to bring a medic (EMT, nurse, doctor) along. Adult leaders will always accompany students outside dorm facility (same expectations for staff presence on young adult trip).
