

# CELEBRATING THE 50,000<sup>TH</sup> PRAYER CROSS!

Over a hundred years ago, the hymnwriter Jessie Pounds wrote these words, "The way of the cross leads home." As people of faith, we find our hope, our salvation, our life not in the things of this world but in the cross of Jesus Christ. It is the place where the pains, sins, and hurts of this world meet the God of redemption and grace. The cross is central to our life of faith here at Hope. A simple cross adorns each of our spaces of worship, a constant and present reminder of the God whose love was so deep that He sent his son Jesus into the world.



In 2016, a small group of men at Hope began making prayer crosses inspired by the handmade cross held by Hope member Ron Messelt in his final days. In the years since, the group has grown, with many men and women cutting, sanding, and branding the cross to be given away to people both locally and globally. These prayer crosses have become part of the fabric and culture of Hope, reminders of the love of God in Jesus that endures through all things. For many they have been a source of comfort and hope, guiding them through the trials of life and for some, leading them home to their Lord. In January of this year the team cut the 50,000th cross and commemorated



it by making a special set of crosses made of olivewood. We celebrate and give thanks to God for the work of these team members but even more for the cross that gives us a new life.

This Lenten season we fix our eyes upon the cross of Christ. We cling to it. We invite you deeper into worship through our Lenten sermon series, "The 10 Commandments," going back to the basics of what it means to live as people of faith. Coming to worship both Wednesday and Sunday will ensure that you get a message on all 10 of the commandments. As you do, pick up a prayer cross to give to someone who needs to be invited to hear about the grace of Jesus, so that they too will know that the way of the cross leads home.


