Scripture Reference

Matthew 14:22-33

Memory Verse John 6:38 Life Point

Jesus is all-powerful because He is the Son of God.

Welcome! Thank you for all you do!

S (Scripture) O (Observation) A (Application) P (Prayer) and Memory Verse

Observation:

- 1. Where did Jesus go after the crowd and disciples were gone? (up on a mountain by Himself to pray)
- 2. What did the disciples shout when they saw someone walking on the water? (it's a ghost)
- 3. What did Jesus tell the disciples? ("It is I. Don't be afraid.")
- 4. When did Peter begin to sink? (when he left the boat and became afraid)
- 5. What happened when Peter called to Jesus for help? (Jesus immediately reached out His hand and caught Peter)
- 6. What did the disciples say when Jesus got out into the boat? ("Truly, You are the Son of God.")

Application:

Discuss: How bad would a storm have to be to terrify the disciples who were professional fishermen? Why do you think Jesus' disciples were amazed at His ability to walk on the water and calm the storm when they had already seen Him do miracles? Show kids the Galilee Boat photo telling kids this boat is like the fishing boats that Peter and some of the other disciples in Jesus' day used.

Prayer:

Pray, thanking Jesus for being the all-powerful Son of God. Thank Jesus for His power to save us from our sins. Ask God to help us to trust Jesus more.

Memory Verse:

Find John 6:38 and challenge kids to name: the testament where they can find the verse (New) and the division where they can find the verse (Gospels). Ask them if they know what the word Gospel means (good news).

Memory Verse:

"For I have come down from heaven not to do my will but to do the will of him who sent me." John 6:38
