Often you can learn as much about someone by the questions he asks as the answers he gives. This appears to have happened with Jesus. He astounded onlookers with His questions, understanding, and answers.

Picture yourself as Jesus' earthly parent who took Him regularly to worship services. You would know—at least on some level—that He was God's Son. How hard would it have been to understand this situation? Interestingly, even though He was God, Jesus was obedient to His parents.

Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and He grew in favor with God and people. Do you think you have grown in godly wisdom over the years? How does growing in favor with God affect how you view people and how others view you?

Think about the kids you teach. How do you see God prompting wisdom and favor in each of them? How might God want you to continue nurturing that growth?
