<b>LEAD GROUP IN SOAP TIME</b>	<b>SOAP</b>
<b>SCRIPTURE:</b>	*Each week you will read in God’s Word as a small group. Mark 5:1-20
<b>OBSERVATION:</b>	*We will review questions about what the kids learned.  <b>2/3:</b> What did Jesus tell the man after he asked him if he could go with him? (No, go and tell other people about what the Lord has done for you.) What is our job as followers of Jesus? (to tell others about Jesus)  <b>4/5:</b> What does possessed mean? (a person completely controlled by an evil spirit) What is a demon? (an evil spirit or devil)
<b>APPLICATION:</b>	The story shows us Jesus can defeat all evil. We know that Jesus is stronger than Satan. The Bible says that the devil wants to kill, steal, and destroy us. Jesus is the opposite. Jesus wants to help us.
<b>PRAYER:</b>	*Please take this time to talk about any prayer concerns of the kids or yours. Pray for the kids regarding those concerns.
