Scripture Commentary

This passage of Scripture reminds us that God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble. Bartimaeus is a blind man who knows that He is a sinner in need of a Savior. When Jesus comes by, He doesn't demand to be healed, but asks Jesus to have mercy on Him. Jesus answers by giving Him sight – physically and spiritually.
