

<ol> <li>Jesus is baptized, endures temptation, and gets to work calling disciples, healing the sick and preaching the Word.</li> <li>Jesus' ministry involved action and times of reflection and prayer.</li> <li>Jesus' teaching and healing point to His being the long-awaited Messiah.</li> </ol>


