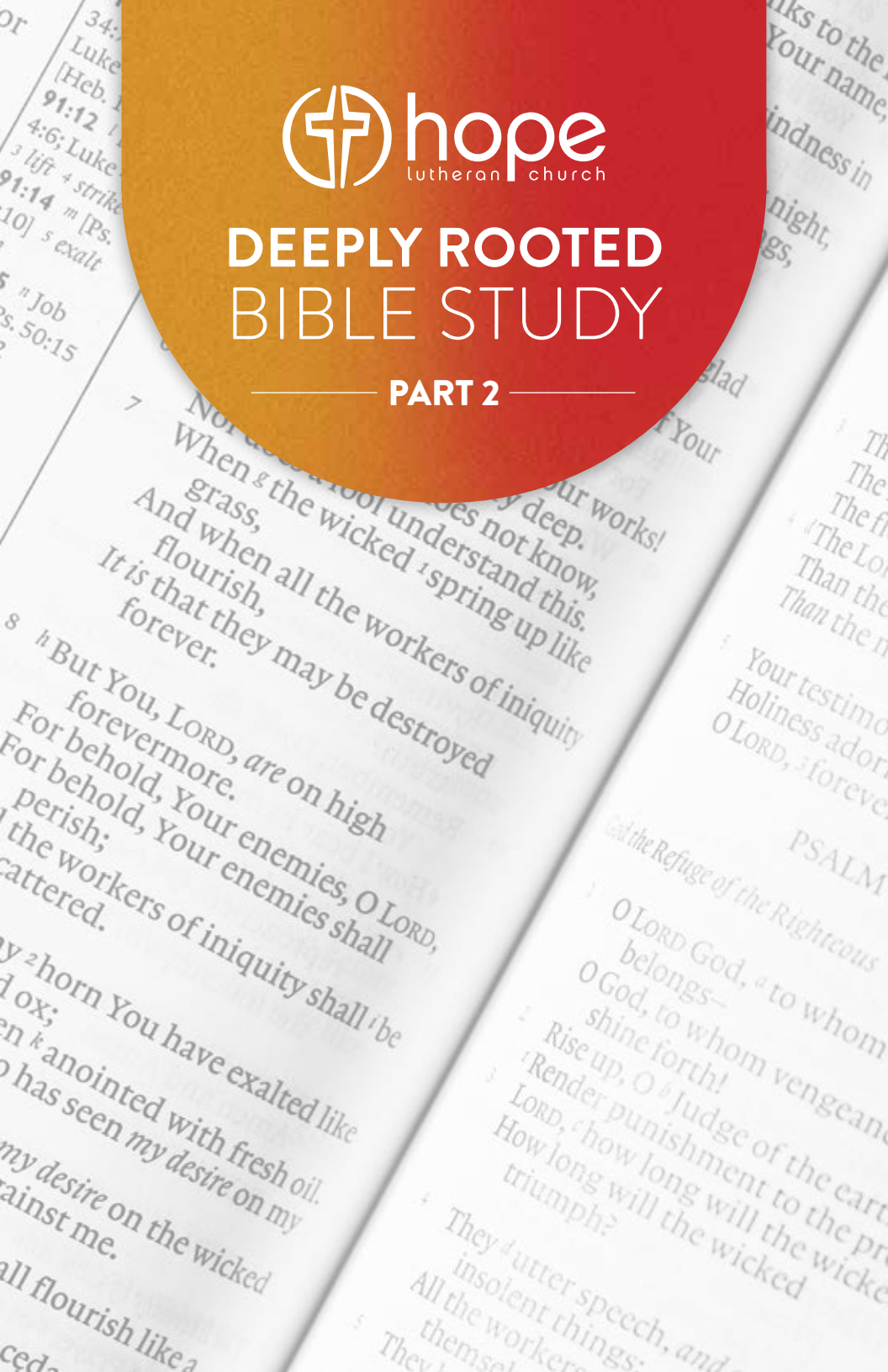
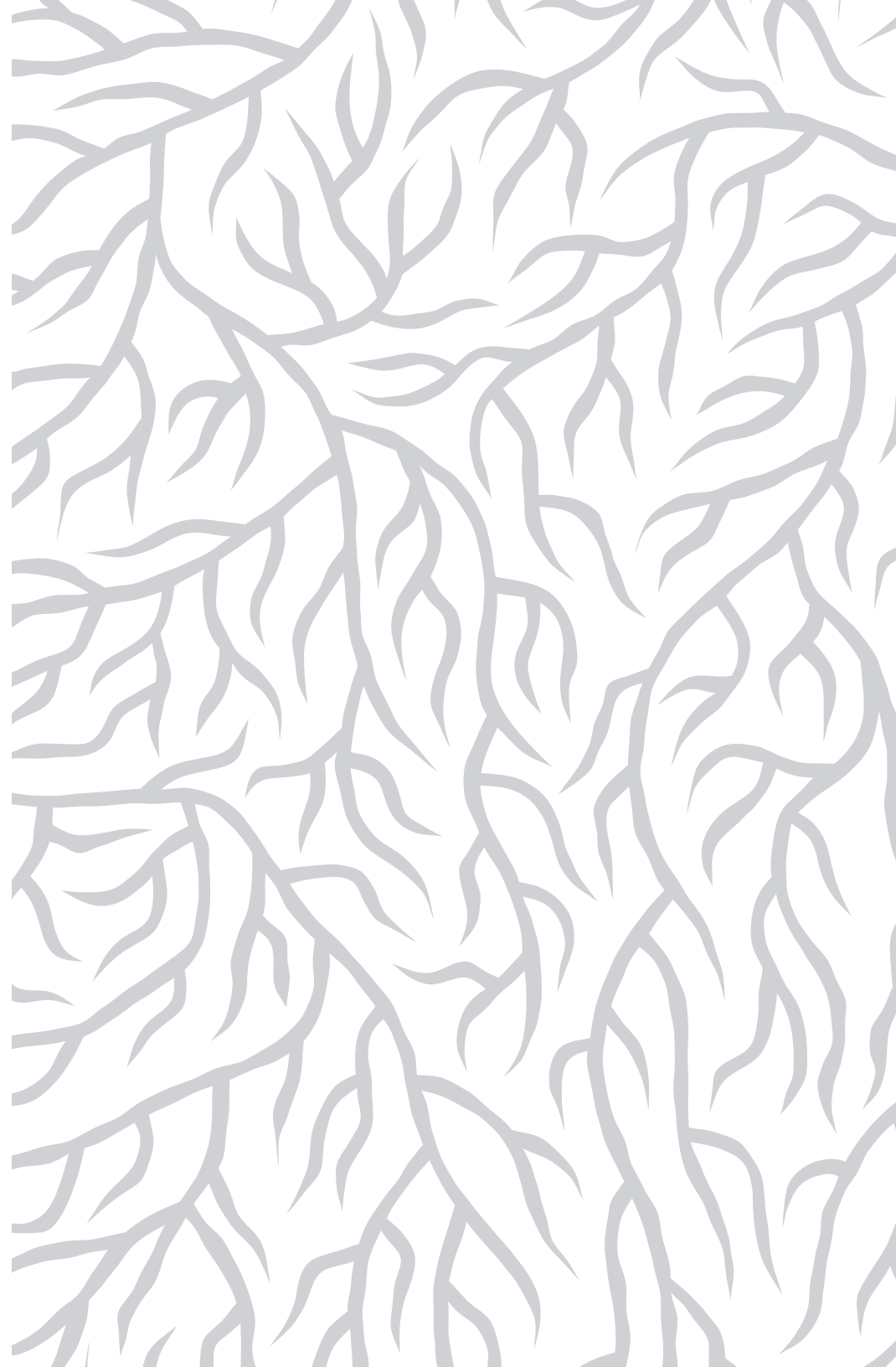

Engaging the text:

Teaching Points:

1. Jesus is baptized, endures temptation, and gets to work calling disciples, healing the sick and preaching the Word.
2. Jesus' ministry involved action and times of reflection and prayer.
3. Jesus' teaching and healing point to His being the long-awaited Messiah.

3. Jesus shows the people that the Messiah came to usher in a New Covenant, not check all the boxes the Pharisees wanted him to check.

1. Jesus begins teaching the people about faith and the kingdom of God.

3. Jesus exercises authority over creation, displaying He is the One they should place their faith in.

3. Jesus came to bring physical and spiritual life to the dead.

Engaging the text:

1. Jesus' compassion drives him to action in caring for people and explaining to his disciples.

3. Jesus brings hope and healing now and for eternity.

1. Jesus points the people to the ultimate authority – God.
2. People have limited minds and thoughts that quickly turn to the temporary things we can easily grasp.
3. Jesus convicts those who teach the law of not knowing the scriptures or the power of God; he points to the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, as the living God.
