WHERE WILL I BE?	What will I do/say?
SIT AT SMALL GROUP TABLE – GREET FAMILIES & CHECK IN KIDS	PRE- HOUR- Please arrive 15 minutes prior to the hour. Welcome kids as we get ready to parade in church with Palms.
THE POINT	We can celebrate Jesus, the crucified and risen king.
MEMORY VERSE	“If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. Romans 10:9
	LARGE GROUP TIME
	Encourage kids to listen to the lead teacher. You will be coming back from singing “Praise” in church. Sit at tables and LT will guide you. The Last Supper – we will be having crackers and juice as the story is being read. Hand out bookmarks and ribbon. Lead Teacher will welcome you all to the Last Supper. READ: Mark 14:12-26 We will be taking turns going to each of the three/four stations. The LT will direct you where your group will start.
There will be three stations.	STATIONS
#1: The Garden Prayer:	Read Mark 14:32-42 Here Jesus shows us the greatest example of how we are to turn to God for all our needs through prayer. We will be writing a prayer to Jesus thanking him that we can pray to him about everything. Asking for help to pray for his will in every situation.
#2: GOOD FRIDAY:	Read Mark 15:21-39 Students will be fingerprinting a canvas. Each child will use a finger of their choosing. We will be using washable markers.
#3: At the Cross:	Read Mark 15:42-47 Ask the kids “Why did Jesus have to die?” Remind them Jesus was nailed to the cross because he loves (insert child’s name). Each student will receive a red dot sticker to symbolize the nail mark on Jesus’ hands. They will place on the palm of their hand.
HE LIVES AGAIN!	This will be led by the Lead Teacher. Read Mark 16
LIVING THE STORY	“The Color of Easter” – Each child will be given a white bag and the Color of Easter story along with jellybeans.
