

WHERE WILL I BE?	What will I do/say?
SIT AT SMALL GROUP TABLE – GREET FAMILIES & CHECK IN KIDS	<b>PRE- HOUR-</b> Please arrive 15 minutes prior to the hour. Welcome kids and go through The Point and play the Bible Skills game.
THE POINT	<b>Jesus sends us to spread the good news everywhere!</b>
BIBLE SKILLS	<b>New Testament Cards –</b> For the next unit you will be using these cards to help memorize the books of the New Testament. Today, just take the time to look in the Bible and put them in order.
MEMORY VERSE	<b>“You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere!</b> <b>Acts 1:8</b>  Look up the verse and highlight it in their Bible. Read it together. For the next unit you will be using a globe to help you memorize the verse.

	<b>Encourage kids to listen to the lead teacher.</b> <b>Review All Quiet Signals – model &amp; practice with group if needed.</b>
SIT AT TABLE SMALL GROUP TABLE – LEAD GROUP IN SOAP TIME	<b>SOAP</b>
<b>SCRIPTURE:</b>	*Each week you will read in God’s Word as a small group.  Acts 1:1-14
<b>OBSERVATION:</b>	*We will review questions about what the kids learned.  What does gospel mean? (good news) What was your favorite part of the story and why? What is God saying to you?
<b>APPLICATION:</b>	How are you sharing the good news with everyone? This week at school, home, etc. Why are you or why not?
<b>PRAYER:</b>	*We will supply you with a prayer to read as a group. Or you can pray your own personal prayer. Please write in prayer requests of kids or your own. I would be blessed to pray for you and your group.  Heavenly Father, you are a good, good father who hears us when we pray. We ask that you put people in our lives which we can encourage and help them to grow in their relationship to Christ. Amen

<b>LIVING OR LEARNING THE STORY</b>	<b>John 3:16 Cards:</b> Have kids look up John 3:16 in their Bibles. Put verse in order. Talk about what this verse means to them. Discuss: throughout scripture we are called to spread the good news, share God's love and His word with everyone and make disciples of all nations.  It can be confusing, intimidating and even frustrating at times. Here are some truths for us in sharing Jesus' love with others: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. We tend to make it way harder than it needs to be. Sharing his love should not be complicated. Think of it this way – Jesus first (who He is to us) Jesus second (what He did for us). Keep it simple. Discuss.</li><li>2. We have everything needed to do what He has called us to do. We have the Holy Spirit who guides and teaches us.</li><li>3. We need to trust Him to do what only He can do.</li></ol>
