

## **Elizabeth, Zechariah, and John the Baptist**

### **Introduction:**

Much of our advent focus centers on the Holy Family: Mary, Joseph, and the baby Jesus. They are at the center of the manger scene, but there is another holy family, that helps us to understand the story of God. Elizabeth, a relative of Mary, her husband Zechariah, and their soon-to-be-born baby, John, are some of the first to realize the magnitude of the birth of Jesus. The baby that Elizabeth and Zechariah welcome into the world is one who will announce the coming of the Lord. John will grow up and speak the words from Isaiah 40, “prepare the way for the Lord.”

In so many ways, we are called to be like Elizabeth, Zechariah, and John. Jesus is coming. Our job, like the second holy family, is to prepare the way, to announce his coming and to fill every corner of the world with the hope that comes with him.
