Holy Spirit: Wind & Fire | Gifts of the Spirit

Introduction:

The Holy Spirit gives us gifts. These gifts are different from natural abilities. Natural abilities are skills or talents that belong to an individual that are part of what make them unique. Spiritual gifts belong to the Holy Spirit and represent God's power and presence in our lives. The Apostle Paul describes gifts in 1 Corinthians 12 as a "manifestation of the Spirit for the common good." Spiritual gifts serve the purpose of "building up the body of Christ" (Ephesians 4:12). Spiritual gifts can be seen because they bear fruit in our lives. Therefore, the gifts of the Spirit, are the direct work of the Holy Spirit's presence in our lives to bring about God's will and kingdom.
