<b>Lesson:</b>	Come, See the Lamb
<b>Callback:</b>	<b>LT:</b> Jesus Calls Us <b>Students:</b> To Abundant Life
<b>Memory Verse:</b>	<b>HOT Seat!</b> (LT will lead this and it will be used for all of Unit 5.)
<b>SOAP:</b>	SGG reads John 1:19-51 to the students.
<b>Observation</b>	Let's Talk About Jesus – students will take turns finishing the following sentences: 1. Jesus is my friend because 2. I go to church because 3. I know Jesus loves me because 4. We can pray to Jesus for
<b>Application</b>	<b>ALL ABOUT ME:</b> John The Baptist was very clear about his priorities – he spent his life talking about Jesus and pointing the way so others could find and experience Him. Sometimes knowing what our priorities are is not an easy thing so we are going to fill out this ALL ABOUT ME sheet which will be about “you” to see what our lives point to. Take turns letting the students share their sheets.  We can tell a lot about ourselves by what we think is important and by what we spend most of our time doing or talking about.
<b>Activity</b>	<b>Eye Spy – with a Twist:</b> The goal of the game is to give as many clues as possible before someone guesses the object. If you would like you can keep track of

	<p>how many clues it takes for the object to be guessed.</p> <p>Each student will take turns thinking about an object that they expect everyone would know(ex. Chair). Then they give clues about that object without giving the object away. Clues should be helpful but tricky.</p> <p><b>Example:</b> clues for chair – it is made of wood, comes in many colors, in churches, schools, and homes, people use it, some are comfy, FINAL clue would be people sit on it!</p>
