Observation Questions:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Who was in prison/jail? Paul and Silas 2. Were they scared? No, God would protect them. 3. What did God send to the prison? An Earthquake 4. How did the guard feel? Scared. 5. Did Paul and Silas run away? No, they stayed. 6. What did the guard do next? Brought them to his house and Paul and Silas shared about Jesus with his family.
Application/Activity:	<p><u>Chain Breaker</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. You are each going to get a paper chain. 2. You can either write something on the chain, draw a picture or just verbally say something that you know is something you do that it is not good. Such as, hitting your sibling, not listening to your parents, taking things without asking. 3. Then once you have said it/written it you get to break the chain (tear it) and then bring it to the cross. Jesus can take those chains from us. If we follow Jesus, we don't have to make these bad choices! <p><u>Superheroes for Jesus</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Next, you are going to color a shield that represents being a superhero for Jesus. Going out and sharing the good news of what Jesus did for us to everyone we know. We don't need to be scared!
